Bay Buddies is for **rising 3rd and 4th graders**. To apply, complete and return application by March 15th, 2026. Camp enrollment will be completed via a lottery system. Maximum of 24 campers will be selected.

## Chesapeake Champions July 27-31



### 5th & 6th Grade

Study and explore different habitats within the watershed. **Rising 5th and 6th graders** will go canoeing and seining, dissect squid, and use a variety

of scientific tools including water quality equipment and microscopes!

To apply, complete and return application and students' statement of interest by March 15th, 2026. Maximum of 24 campers will be selected.

## Estuary Explorers - Aug 2-7



### 7th & 8th Grade

Rising 7th and 8th graders will explore the bayside and oceanside of the Eastern Shore while **staying overnight** at the VIMS Eastern Shore Laboratory in Wachapreague, VA!

To apply, complete and return application and students' statement of interest by March 15th, 2026. Maximum of 16 students will be selected.

The application period opens February 16, 2026 and will close on March 15, 2026. All students will be notified of acceptance into camps on March 27th.
